Job Description

- This position reports directly to the Maintenance Supervisor and will assist the Maintenance Supervisor in the management of the department in the event of his or her absence.
- Under general supervision, performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled or unskilled tasks in the construction, maintenance, and servicing of City streets, facilities, culvert's, street signs, tree trimming and equipment; performs related duties as required.
- Work requires climbing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, standing, walking, pushing and pulling. This position is subject to outside environmental conditions, including extreme cold, extreme heat, hazards, and atmospheric conditions.

Qualifications

- Minimum Education of High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Must possess a valid driver's license in order to use city vehicles and equipment
- Must be a citizen of the United States or have legal work status.
- No felony convictions within the last 10 years, No misdemeanors above a class C in the past 5 years.
