Job Description

- This position reports directly to the Maintenance Supervisor and will assist the Maintenance Supervisor in the maintenance and upkeep of all City grounds and right of ways.
- Under general supervision, performs a variety of skilled, semi-skilled or unskilled tasks in the maintenance of City facilities, right of ways, culvert's, tree trimming, and other related duties as required.
- Work requires climbing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, standing, walking, pushing and pulling. This position is subject to outside environmental conditions, including extreme cold, extreme heat, hazards, and atmospheric conditions.

Qualifications

- Minimum Education of High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Must possess a valid driver's license in order to use city vehicles and equipment
- Must be a citizen of the United States or have legal work status.
