Thank you to all who came out to the Meet the Candidate this past Tuesday, October 11th at the Oran White Civic Center. There were several questions asked and answered by the six people who are running for City Council in this November's election.

I want to bring to your attention the creation of two committees that I believe each citizen will be glad to know about.

First, a park committee, which will be an extension of the Park Informationals that were held the entire month of September. This committee will be composed of one sitting council member, one staff member and three members of the public. This committee's purpose is still being sorted out. But I know they will have a impact on the vision of the park in the future. Everyone will be invited to see the work of this committee, which I hope to see come together by the first of next year.

The next committee is the Fiscal Affairs Committee, which is a more concrete idea. This committee will be charged with overseeing and being involved in the financial status of the city, as well as giving recommendations to the City Council on where they would like to see dollars spent in the city. The composition is the same as the park committee, but these folks will have to be appointed by Council.
