Dear Tool,

If you have been waiting to provide your donation for the proposed park, I have good news for you!

The Eight at Tool, Inc., the fundraising arm of the park, is now a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. This means that donors can deduct their contributions they make to the organization under IRC Section 170. This is an essential step in the direction for the park – if the City Council votes to approve a contract from Red River Recreation. Staff is expecting that contract to come before the City Council at the November 18th meeting.

Earlier this week, Chief of Police Reid Rossmann announced his resignation from the city of Tool. Rossmann has been employed by the city for 15 months and has dedicated his resources and efforts to better the city. Personally, I can thank Rossmann for his time with the city and taking time to not only get to know the public, employees and the Council, but also trying to do the best job he can.
