Thank you to all who joined us at our City Council meeting last night. If you were not there, here are some of the things that you may have missed!

- The City Council approved the replat of 417 Shore Line Dr., creating a .227 acre lot.
- Council approved direction to hire a temporary, part-time City Controller
- Council approved and passed Ordinance 2022-07, Short-Term Rental Regulations. This ordinance outlines the rules and regulations for all Airbnb's, VRBO's and requisite short-term rentals in the city.
- The City will move forward in a possible annexation process with the Cedar Creek LotCO, LLC and The Groves at Cedar Creek, LLC.
- The City Council discussed future funding sources for the proposed Eight at Tool City Park, as they received the latest quote from Red River Recreation.
- The City Council discussed possible City Hall Design and Renovative Services, in relation to City Hall.
