Consider, discuss and take action to approve Resolution 2023-02R, entering into an Interlocal Agreement with TexSTAR to continue participation in the public funds investment pool and designate the City Administrator and City Secretary of Tool as "Authorized Representatives." City Administrator Kizzee stated that the TexSTAR account currently holds our \$1.263 million in bond money. City Administrator Kizzee continued by stating that previous members who are no longer with the city are currently the only authorized members on the account, and this resolution will add the City Administrator and City Secretary and remove the previous members. Councilmember Figueroa stated that he would like this to be a permanent standing resolution. Councilmember Fladmark stated that he would like for it to be a continuing resolution as well, that would updated after every election. City Administrator Kizzee agreed that a standing resolution would work. Motion to approve Resolution 2023-02R, entering into an Interlocal Agreement with TexSTAR to continue participation in the public funds investment pool and designate the City Administrator and City Secretary of Tool as "Authorized Representatives" was made by Councilmember Figueroa with second by Councilmember Fladmark. "Pursuant to Texas Government Code section 551.007, members of the public may speak on an agenda item during the citizens comment section of the meeting or at the time the agenda item is called for discussion by the Mayor. Speakers must sign up with the City Secretary to speak and shall be given three (3) minutes to speak. A speaker needing a translator and/or interpreter may be given six (6) minutes to speak. Criticism of city employees or staff is prohibited. Those wishing to address the Council regarding an item not on the agenda must be a citizen, property owner or business owner of Tool. Comments on such non-agenda items shall be limited to three minutes. The Council will not comment onitems not on the agenda; however, the Council may refer the item to city staff for research, resolution or referral of the matter to the Council as a future agenda item."
